*Explore Israel's history, politics, geography and sociology in an exciting and interactive way.*

## TOPICS INCLUDING:

**Israel 360:** Learn about Israel, its culture, and what makes the country unique.

**Israel and the West:** Learn about the Jewish values that are the foundation of Israeli and Western culture.

**History of the Land of Israel:** Be introduced to the two differing narratives of the Middle East conflict, and learn about the Jewish people's historical connection to the Land of Israel.

**The Birth of Zionism:** Discuss the founding of modern Zionism and the building blocks of the State of Israel.

**Peace and War:** Learn about the wars and terror offensives waged against Israel and will identify the main obstacles on the road to peace.

**Negotiating Parties:** Study Israel's efforts to achieve peace through negotiations and the responses it has received from the Palestinian leadership.

**Negotiating Peace:** Participate in a simulation in which you will attempt to negotiate a peace treaty between the Israelis and Palestinians.

**The Disengagement:** Explore Israel's unilateral disengagement from Gaza and the political and social reactions to this concession.

**US and Israel:** Examine facts and myths surrounding Israel's relationship with the US.

**A Radical Threat:** Learn about the global threat of radical Islam and its role as a shared threat that unites Israel and the US.

**Israel Aid:** Discover more about Israel's global humanitarian aid and relief programs.

**Hi-Tech Highlights:** Learn about Israel's world contributions in areas of medical, diagnostic, environmental and technological advancements.

**Media Bias:** Learn about forms of anti-Israel media bias and discuss the rationale behind the world's preconceptions of Israel.

**The Case for Israel:** Review key points regarding Israel's position in the Middle East conflict through Professor Alan Dershowitz's film *"The Case for Israel"*

**Israel Update:** Study current events in the Israeli-Palestinian conflict, including the Lebanon war, Operation Cast Lead and the Gaza Flotilla.

**Crossing the Line:** Examine anti-Israel and anti-Semitic attacks occurring on North-American university campuses.

**The Israel Challenge:** Have an opportunity to put their education into action by learning and implementing techniques that will allow them to respond to challenges in support of Israel.
