In the commercial where the cat protects the car from the parking enforcement officer about to give a ticket, we learn that when you're friendly to the environment, the environment is friendly in return. One of the ways Israel is friendly to the environment is through the prevalent use of a device that turns solar energy to heat - "Dude Shemesh" solar water heaters. This innovation, which has been exported around the world, harnesses the sun's rays and uses them to heat water, saving much electricity. Since the 1980s, a law requires the installation of solar water heaters on every new building. Another environmentally friendly person is visible in the background of the clip - he's riding a bicycle. What color is his helmet?
